Prohibited Uses for Commercial Space

- 1. Adult entertainment establishments, including strip clubs or other businesses that cater to adult-only activities
- 2. Check cashing operations
- 3. Pawn shops
- 4. Tattoo parlor
- 5. Title loan businesses
- 6. Cigar bar or other establishment where smoking is permitted
- 7. Disco, night club, cocktail lounge or bar (excluding sit-down restaurants having an alcoholic beverage permit but including any store the principal business of which is the sale of alcoholic beverages for consumption off-site)
- 8. Massage or sun tanning parlor
- 9. Amusement center or arcade
- 10. Funeral parlor
- 11. Dry cleaning establishments in which cleaning services occur on the premises (excluding drop-off dry cleaners)
- 12. Liquidator/flea market type of operation
- 13. Soup kitchen or other free food distribution center except in connection with periodic community service activities or during emergency conditions
- 14. Pool hall
- 15. Political campaign headquarters
- 16. Any other prohibited uses under the applicable zoning code of the City of Bradenton
- 17. Adult bookstore and the sale/exhibition of pornographic material
- 18. Liquor store or bar
- 19. Methadone clinic
- 20. Marijuana dispensary (medical or recreational)
- 21. Bus station or other transportation depot (except to the extent necessary to transport children to and from the premises)
- 22. Restaurant where liquor sales exceed approximately 25%-30% of total revenues
- 23. No fast food establishments, restaurants serving primarily fried food or establishments with liquor licenses/sales are permitted without consent. Grocery stores, sandwich shops, stores with deli counters, cafes, bakeries, health food stores, salad bars, juice bars or similar services or establishments are permitted
- 24. Mail box service facility
- 25. Employment agency—specifically a day laborer agency
- 26. Cinema—small screen, limited seating only will be considered
- 27. All Weapons
- 28. Unregulated or Unlicensed Gaming establishment
- 29. Tobacco store or establishment
- 30. Payday Lending business
- 31. Opioids
